Paying for Student Rotations with AMO

Options that work for your school's programming.

With an AMO partnership agreement, your school remains in full control over how the costs of your student's clinical rotations are covered.





SCHOOL-FUNDED ROTATIONS: A SEAMLESS STUDENT EXPERIENCE

Schools that pay on behalf of their students typically incorporate the cost of rotations into their tuition or utilize other funding sources at their university. Use your AMO Manager Account to set available programs based on curricular fit.

All your students need to do is select the program that works for them. You can also use your Manager Account to reserve programs on behalf of your students.



THE STUDENT PAYER OPTION

A more traditional payment model where students individually cover the costs of their rotations. You are still able to select the programs that are available to students based on curricular fit, but typically students will choose their own programs in this model rather than having programs selected on their behalf.



A PARTIAL SCHOLARSHIP OPTION

Providing a partial scholarship blends the above payment options together. Through this option, AMO works with you to establish a discount price of the scholarship award. AMO will then generally match with a discount on our end as well. Then your school operates a scholarship process for students to apply for the award. Your school remains in full control over who and how many students receive the scholarship.



SAVE WITH COHORTS

Rotating your students as a cohort provides extra savings for them and for your school.

For cohort sizes of 10–19 students, AMO covers \$199 USD of each student's malpractice insurance per four-week rotation. AMO also covers the costs of a one-hour HIPPA training course per student.

For cohorts of 20 or more students, AMO offers the above savings, but provides an additional \$150 USD discount off each rotation.
