The Simulation Lab

The Simulation Lab at Jersey Shore leads the way in innovating how medical care is taught and learned. Through the simulation lab, students undergo an experiential and simulation-based training that replicates patient interactions and prioritizes patient safety.

Equipped with examination rooms, students play an active role in their own learning. These rooms provide students with an environment modeled after real-world clinical settings where students interact with patients under professional supervision. The lab develops clinical muscle memory, providing a space for students to safely make mistakes, learn, and retry.

The simulation lab provides a learning experience designed to move students closer to their personal education and professional goals. Benefits of the experience include:
