Fellowship Expectations

Fellows will work with a team of physicians in a multimodal learning environment as they develop new skills in rehabilitating patients with complex wounds.

Fellows can expect to:

- ✓ Work with patients of all ages
- Split time between the wound center and clinic
- Learn advance technologies in wound care

In addition to the above, fellows can expect to learn advance technologies, gaining competencies in:

- The role of oxygen in wound healing
- √ Hyperbaric oxygen therapy
- ✓ Punch biopsy
- √ Application of cell- and tissuebased therapies
- √ Negative pressure therapy

Who is Eligible?

The fellowship is open to all medical students, including pre-med students, medical students, and medical school graduates. For students or graduates outside the U.S., the fellowship sponsors a J-1 Visa.
