



Nine-Week Immersive Medical English + Clinical Experience

AM Opportunities and the University of Oregon's American English Institute are hosting an exclusive nine-week program that includes an intensive five-week medical English program at University of Oregon's campus and a four-week clinical experience through AMO.

About the Program

AEI's program promotes language learning and immersion for international medical students. Over the course of five weeks, students will build medical English skills that they will then apply in a post-program clinical experience in the specialty and location of their choice.

Developed in collaboration with the Pre-Med Program at the University of Oregon's American English Institute, the curriculum features:

- Medical English themes
- Weekly lectures
- Taking patient history
- Case studies
- Conversation role-play
- Bedside manner

Why UO's American English Institute

Beyond a curriculum, the AEI provides a well-rounded academic experience. Uniquely designed for future medical professionals, students can focus on linguistic areas relevant to their needs such as:

- Building patient rapport
- Giving instruction
- Gathering information
- Communicating empathetically

AEI's program also provides students with an F-1 visa and includes the I-9 documentation necessary to secure the visa.

Upon completion of the program, students will receive:

- Letter of completion from the University of Oregon
- Letter of recommendation from the clinical experience attending physician
- Letter of completion from AMOopportunities

COST AND LOGISTICS

The program is priced at **\$9,999** and gives students access to:

- ✓ A four-week post-program clinical experience
- ✓ A bus pass for access to the entire Eugene/Springfield area
- ✓ Full access to the UO Rec Center
- ✓ Full access to the UO library, computer labs, and other student services

Health insurance and access to the UO health center are not included in the program

HOUSING AVAILABILITY

The program is available in two sessions, Summer 2023 and Winter 2024.

Summer 2023

July 3 – August 4

Students are provided with on-campus housing in a UO residential hall and will receive a deluxe meal plan.

Winter 2024

January 2 – February 2

Students live off-campus with AEI-vetted host families. Students will receive breakfast and dinner six days per week. Host family fees are included in program costs.
